

On behalf of the *Southern Colorado Chapter of the American Society of Safety Professionals*, we would like to extend our sincere appreciation for your support of our 11th Annual Golf Outing at The Broadmoor Hotel and Resort West Course. In-person **check-in** opens at **1:00 pm**. **Online check-in is available now (and get your fruit tape “strings” and mulligans early).**

Plan to arrive with plenty of time to catch the shuttle from the parking lot, to the clubhouse (masks provided on the shuttle for everyone’s safety). Then a shuttle will take you to your T-box and golf cart. You will have an opportunity to hit the driving range or practice a few putts if you’d like.

We want to make sure everyone has an **enjoyable and safe day**. So here are a few rules for us all to follow:

1. Drink and drive responsibly
2. Proper golf attire is a must – **No Jeans, soft spike shoes only**
3. Watch the weather and observe for lightning; listen for announcements
4. Keep feet, legs and arms inside the golf cart
5. Don’t hit into the team ahead of you
6. When a golfer uses a mulligan, discard a mulligan candy:
 - a) A mulligan can be used on any shot except a putt
 - b) Only one mulligan per team can be used for a drive on any hole
7. Putting fruit tape is sold and used in 1 foot sections, even if you only use 4 inches. **For example:** if a putt is 20 inches away, then 2 feet of fruit tape must be used; for a putt of 25 inches away then 3 feet of fruit tape must be used.
8. We are playing “scramble” golf (some people call this “best ball”).
 - a. All members of the team hit from the same spot throughout the hole, using the best shot each time to determine the location of the next shot. **For example:** all team members hit a tee shot, the location of the best tee shot becomes the spot from which all players hit their second shot, and so on.
9. **Each player must contribute at least 2 drives** to the team during the round.
10. Maximum score on any hole will be double bogey. If the team reaches double bogey, pick up and move on. This will keep the tournament pace on track.



