Hello,

On behalf of the Southern Colorado Chapter of the American Society of Safety Professionals, we would like to extend our thanks and appreciation to all of you for supporting our 12th Annual Golf Outing at the United States Air Force Academy Eisenhower Silver Course. Registration opens at **7:00am** so plan to arrive with plenty of time to hit a few balls on the driving range or practice a few putts so you're ready for the shotgun start at **8:00am**. We plan to start promptly. We want to make sure everyone has an **enjoyable and safe day**. Here are a few rules for us all to follow:

1. Proper golf attire Eisenhower has clean, collared shirts for loan if guest has no appropriate shirts to wear
2. Drink and "drive" responsibly
3. Watch the weather and observe for lightning; listen for announcements
4. Keep feet, legs and arms inside the golf cart
5. Don't hit into the team ahead of you
6. When a golfer uses a **mulligan**, use a sucker for a "sucky shot":
 - a) Maximum of two mulligans per player
 - b) A mulligan can be used on any shot except a putt
 - c) Only one mulligan per team can be used for a drive on any hole
7. Putting **fruit rollup strips** are sold by the foot sections and are to be used in 1 foot sections (even if you only use 4 inches). **For example:** if a putt is 20" away, the entire 2 feet of string must be used; for a putt of 2'-1" then 4 feet of fruit roll up must be used – maximum of **4 feet of string per player**.
8. We are playing "**scramble**" golf (most people call this "best ball").
 - a. All members of the team hit from the same spot throughout the hole, using the best shot each time to determine the location of the next shot. **For example:** all team members hit a tee shot, the location of the best tee shot becomes the spot from which all players hit their second shot, and so on.
9. **Each player must contribute at least 2 drives** to the team during the round.
10. Maximum score on any hole will be double bogey. If the team reaches double bogey, pick up and move on. This will help with keeping the pace of the tournament on track
